<b>PGT</b> (Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Maths, History, Geography, Economics, English, Hindi, Commerce, IT, Food Production & Beverage and Bio-Tech.)
<b>TGT</b> (Hindi, English, Science, Social Science, Maths, Urdu, Punjabi and Marathi)

**Age as on 31.05.2017 : upto 62 years (for retired teachers from Govt. controlled institution)**

(Condition of B.Ed. is not required)

<b>ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR TGTs &amp; Female Staff Nurse</b>	
<b>TGTs</b>	<b>Bachelor degree in relevant subject with 50% marks or above in aggregate as well as in the concerned subject during all the years of study and B.Ed.</b>
<b>SUBJECT COMBINATION IN GRADUATION FOR TGTs</b>	
TGT (Science)	Botany, Zoology & Chemistry.
TGT (Maths)	Maths, Physics & Chemistry.
TGT (Social Science)	History with Geography/Economics/Political Science, OR Geography with History/Economics/Political Science.
TGT (Hindi, English, Urdu, Marathi)	Candidate must have studied Hindi, English, Urdu as Elective Subject at Graduation Level.
FCSA	Graduation with Diploma in Computer Application <b>OR</b> 'A' Level Certification from DOEACC <b>OR</b> BCA from recognized University/Institution.

**NB:**

- i). **Preference will be given to the CTET qualified candidate (Paper-II) for TGTs only conducted by CBSE**
- ii) In absence/non-availability of above candidates preference should be given to those candidates who had worked earlier in Central Govt. Organization.
- iii) Retired teachers up to the age of 62 years may be engaged subject to their fitness and willingness.
- iv) A candidate with B.Sc. (Computer Science) having Computer Science as one of the subject at graduation level and having additional qualification of MCA is not eligible for the post of FCSA in accordance with the instruction of the Samiti because such candidates are studying other subjects at B.Sc. level and computer Science substitutes only one subject.
- v) Further in case of PGT (IT)/PGT (Bio-Technology) and FCSA weightage to B.Ed. may not be given as B.Ed. is not required for these posts.
- vi) For FCSA CTET is not required.
- vii) 50% Marks is required in total for 3 years in the subject concerned at Graduation level i.e. total of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year in graduation as well as subject combination as the case may be, for TGTs (English, Hindi, Maths, Social Science, Science, Urdu, Punjabi and Marathi) as per Samiti instructions. It is not necessary to have 50% marks every year individually in the subject(s) of graduation.
